**1. Apologies**

**4. Planning Application**

**a. 13/00957/TPO – Crown reduction of 1 No yew tree by 25% making a height reduction of 1.5 metres;** Mr Williamson – Yew Tree Cottage, Mansfield Yard, Main Street.  
The Councillors had canvassed opinions from neighbours and had no objections to the application.

**b. 13/00718/F – Mr and Mrs R Ward, Former Rosemary.**

John Fargin informed the meeting that the developers had made an appeal and it had been announced that day. The Planning Inspector will receive all the submissions made to CDC about the case, but it would not normally be necessary for the Parish Council to make an additional submission unless there was any new information which the Parish might like to make the Planning Inspector aware of.

Following a lengthy discussion the Councillors **RESOLVED** to ask the Clerk to print off all the documents available on the website under all the related applications to enable a detailed review to be undertaken of the complete application process.

It was agreed that the PC had some concerns regarding the way in which CDC had handled the application and the document review may well reveal any issues that should be followed up.

A decision as to whether to apply, under the F o C act, for further documentation is to be made following the appeal.
