As you may be aware HS2 is making available a community fund to mitigate the local disruption that the HS2 project will be causing in our area.

Fringford Parish Council plans to make an application for funding and is writing to seek your comments on a potential improvement project we have identified on the corner of The Green and Main Street/Wise Crescent.

Over the years an area of scrub has grown up to conceal one of the typical stone walls that you will be familiar with throughout Fringford. As a result, the wall has deteriorated to the point where it has virtually disappeared. Also, the overgrown bushes need ongoing trimming to keep them away from the footway and prevent them from obscuring the view of drivers using the adjacent road junction.

We would like to clear the scrub and then rebuild the wall as it was. This would serve to open up the corner, improve the overall visual amenity of the area and enhance the rural scene which we all enjoy.
