Hall Background

The Village Hall building is owned by Fringford Parish Council and is leased to the Fringford Village Hall Charity (No 1077028). The Hall is managed by a dedicated group of local volunteers. The hall was extended and completely renovated in 2015 at a cost of over £240,000.

Hall Facilities

The hall is very well equipped, stylishly but neutrally decorated with excellent multi-level lighting, making it ideal for a wide variety of events of all sizes and types. The hall has a fully accessible toilet with baby changing facilities. Really positive feedback is often provided by both private and commercial hirers...

The Main Hall

The main hall can accommodate as many as 80 people standing and around 50 to 60 seated, depending on layout. A wide range of quality furniture is available to create all kinds of layouts (dining tables, modular meeting tables, etc.). The room has its own servery, ideal for serving drinks, and snacks. Flexible lighting can be set to create many types of mood and atmosphere. It has a recently refurbished sprung beech floor. A large projection screen is available and acoustic panels improve the sound quality of the space.



The Chinnery Room

The smaller Chinnery Room is ideal for smaller gatherings or meetings. It can hold up to 50 people standing or 30 people sitting. It has its own small servery with hot water, fridge, and a sink, ideal for serving drinks. The room houses the Fringford Village History Display, a beautifully curated exhibition of village life in the past.



The Kitchen

The hall's kitchen is bright, spacious, and very well equipped with oven, hob, hot water dispenser, dishwasher, microwave, fridge, and double sinks.

Lots of crockery, glassware and cooking equipment is available. The serving hatch to the main hall makes it very easy to serve food and/or drinks.

The hall is hired for all kinds of events from baby showers, christenings and birthday parties (for all ages) to anniversaries, family gatherings, discos, fund-raising events, formal dinners, wakes, hobby and club meetings, conferences and training sessions.
